

A city in the northern part of Germany by the North Sea. A very important center of sea fishing and fishing industry, a modern seaport. Cuxhaven is also a passenger port with ferry connections to all major North Sea ports. The relatively young city acquired city rights in 1907 while the history of its settlement dates back to 4 thousand years before Christ. Due to its attractive and charming location and excellent therapeutic qualities, it is counted among the most beautiful spas of the North Sea. It is also among the most besieged bathing resorts. Arriving tourists find elegant guesthouses and hotels with a wide range of services provided.

The genesis of contacts with this city is related to Cuxhaven's patronage of Germans displaced during World War II from Pila and its vicinity.
